On 06-10-2013 I responded to the Southend Service Center for Santa Rosa County at 5841 Gulf Breeze Parkway in reference to a burglary. I spoke with the complainant, Joan Chabers who is associated with the Supervisor of Elections and Voting Poll at the Southend Service Center. She advised that when she arrived to that location this morning at approximately 0730 hours, she discovered that two safes containing an IVO Tronic (electronic voting machine), voting ballots and a thumb drive were missing. It was then discovered that the east entrance door lock to the building had been pried open. Ms. Chabers stated that the safes are both approximately 3.5 feet wide by 3 feet tall. One is bronze in color and the other is blue. Southern Light systems representative advised that their alarm sounded at 0219 hours.

I observed the fiber optic cable and PVC piping that encased it had been cut and there were tracks from what appeared to be a truck dolly in the ground on the south east corner of the property outside the building and behind the Southern Light tower. The crime scene was processed by CSI Judy Thomas who was on scene prior to my arrival. At 0225 hours video surveillance recorded one male subject holding a crow bar walking inside from east to west in front of the DHSMV station directly toward the voting poll offices where the safes were kept. The subject left through the same direction as he had came in. This would indicated that he used the east door entrance. He returns, now jogging, a minute later, looks around goes back toward the east, then appears, peaking around a corner that is viewable in camera #5. There is no further activity until 0435 hours when two male subjects show up with a truck dolly. They walk directly to the voting poll office. One of the subjects opens the west entrance door, peeks out, then returns to assist the other subject with the removal of a safe. Both safes are taken out to the east of the camera view. The last view of the subjects is at 0445 hours. Further developments will be documented in a supplement.

On 6/10/13 at approximately 0400 hours I went to the South End Annex to use the restroom. I entered through the south entrance. I walked along the south and east corridor, past the east facing door and exited via the same corridors. I used a key to gain entrance, locked the door behind me, and locked it upon leaving. While inside I did not see, hear, or smell anything out of the ordinary. I did not see any vehicles aside from the usual county vehicles in the parking lot. I was later advised that a burglary had occurred, and that the suspects may have been inside while I was there. I estimate that I was inside the building for ten minutes.

Supervisor of Elections, Tappie Villane informed me of the contents and values of the items contained within the stolen safes which are as follows; contained inside the bronze safe was 850 un-voted ballots, value unknown at this time and one Version flip cell phone with charger, value \$149.00.

Contained inside the blue safe was a DS 200 thumb drive containing collected votes, value \$210.00, two keys to the DS 200 tabulation machine valued at \$6.00, IvoTronic (touch screen that collects votes on a flash card) with compact flash card valued at \$3500.00, Communication Pack Printer valued at \$1200.00, two PEBs valued at \$150.00 each, thirty three early voting ballots along with thirty three voting certificates from Friday and Saturday's voting activity, two absentee ballots, one voter application for a name change, and a notebook containing time sheets and oaths. Both safes were approximately three and a half feet tall by three feet wide. I am awaiting any further information as to serial or model numbers, values, or other descriptive values of stolen items.

I am also awaiting information from Southern Light and Dorma USA, Inc as to costs of damages and other monetary losses incurred as a result of the criminal activity in this case.

REMARKS:

On 06/10/2013 at 0750 hours, I arrived at my office, in the South Santa Rosa County Service Center, and was informed by a Service Center employee the building had been broken into and two safes were missing from the Elections Office. I called Dispatch and Dep. Schmitt arrived on Scene. Unknown suspect(s) had entered the building through the East side building door. I observed the interior door edge to be broken. I proceeded to the Elections Office where I observed cup glasses on the floor, a microwave oven on the floor, paper plates scattered on top of blue containers, napkins on the floor, a large dark container in the front room, which had been moved, damage to the side office door and wall, and a splatter of blood on the carpet near the broken glasses and where the safes had been moved from. Outside the building, on the SouthEast corner of the Light Tower fence, I observed and collected a blue plastic glove (Ex.983-3), from the concrete ground, and observed shoe impressions and dolly tracks on the ground dirt area behind the Light Tower fence. I also observed a rod broken which is on the building's East side of the brick wall. I observed a spot of blood on the carpet floor (Ex.983-2) of the Election Office, which using Phenolphthalein, tested positive for Blood. I also collected a Swab of the Blood (ex.983-4). I collected two Swabs (Ex.983-5) w/possible DNA, from the ext. black handle of a 'Square D'-metal box, which is located inside the fenced area, on the West side of the Light Tower. Using dusting powder, I processed the int./ext. of the East side door, door edge, and glass, the int. of the West side door, door edge, and glass, the ext. of the microwave oven, the outside rod on the brick wall, the metal door of the 'Square D' box, the ext. metal lid of a 'D' box on South side of Light Tower, and the ext. top/handle of the large dark container, in the Elections Office. I recovered two Latent Lifts (S1-S2-983) from the int. East side door glass, one Latent Lift (S3-983) from the int. East side door edge, one Latent Lift (S4-983) from the ext. microwave oven door edge, one Latent Lift (S5-983) from the ext. microwave oven door glass, one Latent Lift (S6-983) from the ext. metal lid-'D' box, one Latent Lift (S7-983) from the ext. rod, two Latent Lifts (S8-9-983) from the int. West side door glass and one Latent Lift (S10-983) from the int. West side door edge.

Phenolphthalein, a chemical presumptive test for detecting the presence of blood, was applied to all questioned stained areas. Any positive areas were swabbed and/or collected for further analysis.

I took 103 color digital photographs (Ex. 983-1) to document the Scene.

Ex.983-1 - Ex.983-5 was submitted to Evidence. The collected latent lifts have been submitted to the Latent Print Examiner for further analysis.

On 06/11/13 Lt Killingsworth and I went to the South End Annex to review the crime scene. We where met there by CSI Thomas who walked us through the crime scene. Thomas told me that she had found a pair of latex gloves, outside the east entrance that had possibly been dropped by the suspects. Thomas also showed me a blood spot that she had located on the carpet in the room were the safes had been removed. I requested that the carpet containing the blood spot be cut out(a small square). This was approved by Lt. Killingsworth and the personnel that were present at the annex. I requested that Thomas send off the blood sample and the gloves to FDLE for possible DNA comparison. I also met with Sgt. Hawkins who showed me the surveillance video from the tower, and I also watched the surveillance video from the annex. Lt Killingsworth and I then drove around the surrounding areas I later made telephone contact with several individuals who told me that they would call me if they receive any suspect information.

On this same date the Health Department was contacted and I was given information that the Health Department located across from the Annex has outside cameras. The cameras only pan the parking lot, but I will be requesting the video be looked at, in case the suspects parked in the parking lot after they cut the optic cables. This investigation is ongoing.

On 06/13/13 I made contact with Del Lewis supervisor for the Health Dpt and requested that she look at the video from the South end office to see if any vehicles came into the parking lot during the hours of the burglary. Ms Lewis called me back and told me that she observed some type of vehicle enter the parking lot at 0138 hrs, and that it turned in ,but immediately left. Ms Lewis told me that she could not determine what type of vehicle it was.

On this same date I made contact with CSI Peters and asked him if he would go to the Milton Health Dpt and view the video to see if a vehicle identification could be made (the video system can only be accessed in Milton). CSI Peters called me back after reviewing the video and told me that the picture quality was so poor that an identification could not be made.

On this same date I called Ron Hixson (supervisor for the Recycling Dpt), and asked him if

there was video available at the Annex recycle bin, who told me that the camera was not operable on the morning of the burglary.

On this same date I called the Zoo to see if they had outside video, and was told that they do not.

On this same date I called the GBPD to see if they had continuing video at their red light cameras, and was told they do not. The video is only activated if a vehicle runs the red light.

RESULTS:

Exhibits 983-2 (carpet), 983-3 (glove) and 983-4 (swabs of carpet) failed to give chemical indications for the presence of blood.

A sample (Exhibit 983-3A) was collected from Exhibit 983-3 (glove) in an attempt to determine the possible wearer of this item.

STR DNA analysis was performed on Exhibit 983-3A (swab of glove) and on a sample from Exhibit 983-5 (handle) utilizing the AmpF/STR Identifier Plus PCR Amplification Kit.

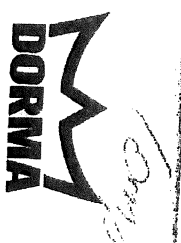

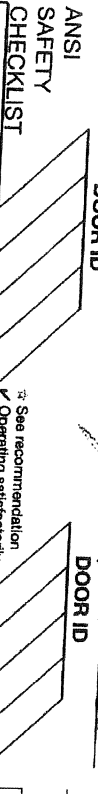
